- 3. Applicants who have certificate of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) which is above N5 level.

#### **Application procedures**

- 1. Please send us a set of application forms (1, 2, 3 and 7.1 of the required documents given below).
- 2. We shall make a final judgment of acceptance of the candidates as an applicant for admission based on the prepared materials and the interview.
- 3. Once receives the judgement of acceptance of the candidates, please send all documents for the application shown below to us.
- 4. Once you receive a copy of the certificate of eligibility from the Tokyo Immigration Bureau, please pay all expenses for the first one year to us.
- 5. As soon as it is confirmed that you has transferred the full amount required for enrollment, we shall send the original certificate of eligibility to you. Please obtain visa in the Japanese embassy or consulate.
  - \* If your visa is not issued or if you decline enrollment for your own convenience, we refund you the tuition fee.

#### Part-time job

After obtaining permission from Immigration Bureau of Japan, student is allowed to do a parttime job for 28 hours per week.

#### **National Health Insurance**

Students who are study on the pre-college visa are required to enroll in the National Health Insurance program. The National Health Insurance covers 70% of medical expenses. Participants are responsible for only 30% of ordinary treatment and the insurance covers the remaining 70%.
